

A few days ago I was at a trade show. Towards the end of the day, as we began to tear down our booth, I noticed the lady in the next booth was worried about something, as if she had misplaced something. I asked her if could help find whatever it was she was looking for. She replied that she couldn't find her keys. I told her that as Muslims we are told that whenever you experience a loss, recite the prayer "Inna lillahi wa inna ilaihi raji'un.", meaning that to Allah we belong and to Him shall we return.
