40 Weekly Fasts

Dear Ansar Brothers, As-Salamu 'Alaikum Wa Rahmatullah

On the green and grey carpets of Baitul Futuh Mosque, 100 of us were sitting a few feet away during the Friday Sermon of February 12, 2016, when Hazrat Khalifatul Masih launched the initiative of 40 weekly fasts, Sadaqat, and prayers. I remember one of us pulling a white napkin out of his pocket and quickly writing down Huzoor's instructions during the sermon!

Yes, 100 officeholders (including a few guests) of Majlis Ansarullah, USA travelled to the fountainhead of Khilafat in UK.

I will return to the objective of writing this message but first let me share some details of the trip.

Our caravan started arriving on Thursday and officially departed London by Monday, February 15. During this time, we offered many Salats (including Jumu'ah Prayer) behind Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V (may Allah be his helper) and were also blessed to have a detailed official Mulaqat on February 13 in Mahmood Hall of Fazal Mosque, London. Huzoor blessed every member with a handshake and gave best Majlis awards and 'Alam-i-In'ami.

In addition, our gracious hosts also took us to Islamabad where we offered prayer at the grave of Hazrat Khalifatul Masih IV, followed by a tour of Jami'ah Ahmadiyya, UK. Next day, we explored the mesmerizing halls of "Makhzan-e-Tasaweer," an exhibition of rare pictorial history of the Ahmadiyya Jama'at. The visit concluded with select planning sessions of ALC on Saturday and Sunday.

Many members paid 100% of their expenses, allowing us to keep all expense well within the allocated budget of ALC.

While pictures and details of Huzoor's guidance will be shared in Al-Nahl, let me now return to the objective of this message: to follow our Khalifah.

It was abundantly clear that Huzoor wants us to be role models of spirituality. Therefore, first of all I request your prayers for every member of Majlis Ansarullah, USA. May Allah the Exalted grant us the humility to bow down even further so we may be accepted; to "leave off everything that fattens your vanity for the door you have been invited to enter is not one that would admit a fat person."

You will be receiving a weekly reminder from Majlis Ansarullah. Please don't ignore it. The world is tumultuous and prayers are our biggest weapon.

We have seen prayers work before. Why wouldn't they work now?







Mohammad Ikramul Haq Jattala Passes Away

Mohammad Ikramul Haq Jattala of LA Inland Majlis passed away on February 1, 2016 at the age of 85, Inna lillahi wa inna ilaihi raji'un. He was born on December 4, 1930. He had been a member of the Los Angeles Jama'at for the past 45 years and was one of the pioneers of the Los Angeles Jama'at.

He is the younger brother of late Ch. Muhammad Ziaul Haq of Virginia. Ahmadiyyat came in the family through their father, Ch. Nabi Bakhsh, who accepted the Promised Messiah (may peace be on him) in the early 1920s.















He served in the Pakistan Air Force and later established an import & export business before moving to the U.S. in 1970. He was the first Pakistani Ahmadi to settle in the Los Angeles area. At the time, there was only one African-American Ahmadi in Los Angeles, Late Brother Rahmat Jamal. Together, these two pioneer members set out to build the Los Angeles Jama'at.

Having served as Qa'id Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya, Montgomery (now Sahiwal),

Pakistan, in the 1960s, he had the good fortune of serving the Jama'at in the Los Angeles area in various capacities. He has been the longest serving Secretary Wasaya for the Los Angeles area. He has been also blessed to serve as President of the Santa Maria Jama'at in the 1990s and Vice President of Los Angeles Inland Jama'at during the 2000s. He was a Musi serving as Secretary Wasaya of LA Inland Jama'at at the time of his passing. He is also known for his service in the building of the Baitul Hameed Mosque in Chino, CA from start to finish.



Mohammad Ikramul Haq Jattala, a man of strong principles, was a true lover and servant of Ahmadiyya Khilafat. He is survived by two sons, 4 grandchildren, and a younger sister. Three of the four grandchildren are Wagifin-i-Nau in the U.S. May Allah elevate his status in the Paradise and shower His immense Mercy on the departed soul and provide solace and comfort to the family members, Ameen.
