First Family Day in Dallas, TX Majlis (Kamran Mirza, Dallas, TX Majlis)




Last year in the Ansar Shura, a proposal was presented that there should be an event in every Jamat in the USA in which Ansar and their families will get together and spend a few hours with each other. It could be held at a mosque, park or any other place, the purpose of this meetup is to bring families closer. The idea was to include multiple interactive sessions with some games

and food. That will allow a better bonding between father,mother and their kids. In May, 2022 Dallas Jama'at conducted the very first family day hosted by Ansar brothers. This session was held on a Saturday evening to make sure that most people would be able to attend. A large majority of Ansar brought their children along with their spouses and daughters. 198 members attended the program. The program consisted of three interactive sessions plus games followed by refreshments.

The three interactive sessions included a father and son communicating with each other on certain issues. These topics and discussion points were provided by the Ansar leadership. The fun part was that the Nasir/father was playing the role of the son and the son/Khadim was playing the role of Nasir/father. This little twist enabled both individuals to understand the point of view of the other party and solve the problem from their standings. The topics chosen were to;

- Discuss about usage of mobile phone all the time
- Discuss about Christmas Tree, its symbolism and how it effects on our children
- Discuss about the importance waking up for Fajr

Daud Khan with his son Maulood Khan, Riyaz Ahmad with his son Aiden Ahmad and Kamran Mirza with his son Rayan Mirza were the participants to conduct the above roles and discussion. All 3 sets were able to discuss the core issues and did their best to come up with solutions for the topic at hand. After each set went over the given script and discussion points, the floor was







open for questions and comments. The whole hall was delighted to be part of the discussion and it was great to see multiple Khuddam and Ansar discussing the topic. Overall it was a very fun, interactive and successful activity.

Later on, everyone was invited to play the game of Tobaa and multiple teams of five participants were formed. Everyone who participated was taught how to play the game and its rules. This activity again brought Ansar and their children together and everyone enjoyed playing the game. After these activities, refreshments were served and every participant of the event got to hang around with their families and friends.
