

Majilis Ansarullah members meet Huzoor in Islamabad

Report published in Al Hakam on 21st December 2023



On 17 December 2023, the national Amila of Ansarullah USA was blessed with the opportunity to meet Hazrat Amirul Momineen, Khalifatul Masih V, may Allah be his Helper, in a mulagat – in Islamabad, UK.

At the outset of the mulaqat, Huzoor conveyed his salaam and led the Amila in a silent prayer.

In the beginning, a video: "Cycling to Ansar Ijtima 2023: The Journey Guided by Khilafat" was presented. In the video presentation, it was mentioned that this plan was initiated following guidance from Huzoor in a meeting held in 2022, during which Huzoor instructed the Amila to undertake long-distance cycling. Following the presentation, Huzoor enquired

He reported a total of 2361 and added that this accounted for approximately 55% of the total Majlis. Upon hearing this, Huzoor remarked, "I see. And only eight or nine of them took part in cycling." Naib Sadr Saf-e-daum further mentioned that their numbers were gradually increasing and highlighted that since Huzoor's visit, in 2022, there had been a significant surge of interest in cycling.

Suhail Kausar Sahib, Naib Sadr Awwal, reported that he had been serving in this position for almost nine years. Huzoor asked him if he would continue in the same position in the next year's Amila. To this, Suhail Kausar Sahib replied in the affirmative. Huzoor smiled and said, "They can't find any young person to take this position?" Huzoor then enquired about his age, to which he replied he would be 75 in January. "Masha-Allah," and Huzoor added, "then quite young."

Mahfooz Sheikh Sahib, Qaid Umumi, reported

that there were 57 Majalis across the country, with the highest concentration of Ansarullah concentration of Ansarullah being primarily in the Baitur Rehman, Virginia and New Jersey regions, followed by New York and New Jersey regions. These were the regions with the most Ansar, he reported. He added that they were receiving monhly reports from each Majalis and added that the comments were also given.

Syed Tanuir Ahmad, Qaid Sehat-e-Jismani, was the next to report. Inquiring about his health, Huzoor asked if he engaged in any exercise. He replied in the affirmative and added that approximately 33% of the members were regular in exercise.

Rizwan Alladin Sahib, Muawin Sadr, reported

that Sadr Sahib would assign him the task of preparing various presentations based on different events and special occasions. He added that there is a "Family Day" for which he prepares the program and presentations. Upon this, Huzoor enquired as to what the "Family Day" entailed. Rizwan Sahib explained that it was a recommendation from Majlis-e-Shura, encouraging families to

gather at their respective centers where food and refreshments are prepared. Huzoor asked about the attendance, and Rizwan Sahib replied that many people attended, though he did not have the exact number. Hearing this, Huzoor reminded him, "You have been Sadr Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya. You should be very much particular and specific on the numbers and everything. That is how you

used to do when you were Sadr Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya." Yasir Khan Sahib, Muawin Sadr, reported that Sadr Sahib assigned him to focus on Wassiyat. Huzoor then asked how many Ansar had joined the system of Wasiyyat. Yasir Khan Sahib reported that 1400 Ansar have done so.

Belal Khalid Sahib, Qaid Talim, reported that they selected the book Pleasant Stories & Anecdotes – the English translation of Hikayat-e-Shirin & Waqi'at-e-Shirin. Huzoor enquired about the number of Ansar who could read Urdu. Belal Khalid Sahib reported that when they gave the test to the Ansar, the majority answered in English, with only a few answering in Urdu. He added that a total of 1420 Ansar participated in the test – which was the highest they had, he reported.

Speaking with Iftikhar Ahmed Sahib, Qaid Ishaat, Huzoor enquired about the existence of any magazine or publication under Ansarullah. Iftikhar Ahmed Sahib confirmed this and mentioned the publication of Al-Nahl Magazine, which he reported was produced annually with over 100 pages each issue. Additionally, he mentioned that electronic newsletters containing articles submitted by local Majlis members were

regularly sent to the entire Majlis. Following this, Kamran Mirza Sahib, Naib Qaid Publications, and Mujeeb Chaudhry Sahib, Qaid Umumi, also had the opportunity to introduce themselves.

Rizwan Ahmad Sahib, serving as the Auditor, was next to report. Huzoor asked him if he was satisfied with the implemented audit system, to which he replied affirmatively. He added that if Huzoor had any guidance, they would certainly implement it. Huzoor responded, "Guidance is that it is already written in your constitution and rules and regulations book – so you should follow that."

Huzoor asked who would be serving as the Auditor the following year, to which he was informed that Javed Khan Sahib would be in that role. Additionally, Huzoor it was reported that Rizwan Ahmad Sahib would be serving as Qaid Tajnid. In response, Huzoor told him, "Update your tajnid, now new immigrants and refugees have come, so include them."

Speaking with Ismail Cudjoe Anani Sahib, originally from Ghana, Huzoor asked how long he had been in the USA. Ismail Cudjoe Anani Sahib replied that he had been living in America for 23 years. Huzoor smiled and said, "Now you are almost an Amercian."

Ismail Cudjoe Anani Sahib reported that he would be serving as Naib Qaid Tarbiyat nau muba'i'in. Huzoor, hearing this, told him, "Make the list of nau muba'i'in - those who did bai'at in the last three years. And then,

make a proper plan for them: how to train them, and what should be the books for them to read – there should be some prescribed books or literature, or some other material so that they know what Ahmadiyyat is and why they became Ahmadies." Huzoor added, Try to bring them into the mainstream of the Jama'at so that they are well-trained."

Mahmood Hanif Sahib, Qaid Mal, was next to report. Huzoor enquired about his profession, to which he replied that he was an IT manager and added that he works in a bank. He then reported and answered various questions asked by Huzoor about budget matters etc.

Mahmood Qureshi Sahib reported he was serving as Zaeem Detroit Majlis and further stated that he would be serving as Nazim-e-A'la Great Lakes Region. He reported that 220 Ansar currently reside in that region.

Saad Mia Sahib, Zaeem Majlis Oshkosh, reported that there were 25 Ansar in his region. Hearing the total number, Huzoor smiled and said, "Very easy job." Huzoor further said, "Your Majlis should be the ideal Majlis."

Ghayyur Manan Sahib, Nazim-e-A'la Southeast Region, reported that the region has five Majalis and the tajnid is 270. Next, Muhammad Laqiduddin Ahmad, Naib Qaid Mal, had the opportunity to introduce himself. Mirza Anas Ahmad, Nazim-e-A'la Central East

Region, reported that there were 416 Ansar in this region.

Fahim Ahmad Sahib reported that he shall be serving as Nazim Southwest Region. He reported that 355 Ansar resided in the area. "You are very much precise about the number of Ansar – in each area. It means you are working." Next, Aftab Jamil Sahib reported that he shall start serving as Nazim-e-A'la for the Central West Region. Then, Ammar bin Talha Sahib reported he would start serving Nazim-e-A'la for Gulf States Region. Haroon Shakoor Sahib reported that he would be serving as Nazim-e-A'la for the Virginia Region starting in 2024. He reported that 571 Ansar are currently residing there.

Fawad Jawad Khan Sahib, Zaeem Ansarullah Los Angeles, reported that, currently, 285 Ansar resided there. Then, Fatihuddin Sahib reported he was serving Baltimore Jama'at as the Zaeem. Syed Mudasir Ahmad Sahib said he will be serving as Nazim-e-A'la of the Southeast Region. He reported that 270 Ansar resided in the region. Zeeshan Virk Sahib reported that he shall be serving as Nazim-e-A'la for the Midwest Region.

Syed Uzair Sahib, serving as Zaeem Seattle,

was next to report. Speaking with him, Huzoor asked if he was related to Dr Tanueer Sahib. Syed Uzair Sahib replied in the affirmative and said he was the youngest brother. Atif Zeeshan Sahib reported that he will be serving as Nazim-e-A'la for Headquarters Region. And Muzaffar Ahmad Chaudhry Sahib reported he was serving as Zaeem Boston Majlis. Muhammad Daud Muneer Sahib, currently serving as Naib Sadr, was next to report. Huzoor asked if he was given any post in the new Amila, to which he replied that he was now retiring. Upon this, Huzoor smiled and jokingly said, "At this age, you should get retirement."

Zahid Mian Sahib, Naib Sadr, reported that he was serving as Naib Sadr in the current Amila and in the next too. Muhammad Ahmad Sahib, currently serving as Qaid Tabligh, reported that in the new Amila, he shall be serving as Naib Sadr Saf-e-Doum. Huzoor told him, "Now you should include more people in your cycling."

Huzoor further said, "There were almost 50-60 people, Ansar, who went from here to Spain on bicycle – Ansarullah UK. So you should work hard. You are quite young."

Mohammad Antwi Sahib. Tahrik-e-Jadid. reported that he shall be serving in this post in the next amila too. He reported that this year they had exceeded their target and added that 3,015 Ansar participated. Hearing this, Huzoor said that the target should be all Ansar. "Each and every nasir should participate Tahirk-e-Jadid - even if they pay 1, 2 or 3 dollars, it doesn't matter. They should know the importance of sacrifice. Make them realise the importance of sacrifice, and new converts as well. Include all the Nau Muba'i'in into this scheme."

Muhammad Shahid Mahmood Sahib, Qaid Tajnid, reported that in the next Amila, he shall serve as Qaid Talim-ul-Quran ad Waqf-e-ardhi. Huzoor said, "Try to include each and every Amila member, and Nazim-e-A'la, and their local Amila members into the scheme of Waqf-e-ardhi. Everyone should do Waqf-e-ardhi for at least two weeks - including yourself."

Tahir Ahmad Sufi Sahib, currently qaid Tarbiyat Nau Muba'i'in, reported that in the new Amila he would be serving as Qaid Isaar. Huzoor asked him if he had made any plan to which he replied in the affirmative and said that he would be continuing the outreach program which includes checking up on the well-being of Ansar brothers. He added that the second goal was to feed one million Americans through the Humanity First chapters and via food banks. After hearing this, Huzoor alluded to the "Model Village Project", to which Tahir Ahmad Sufi Sahib said that they would continue that project.

Muzaffar Ahmad Sadique, currently serving as Qaid Taribiyat, reported that next year he will be retiring. Then, Qamar Zafar Sahib, currently serving as Qaid Isaar, had the opportunity to speak with Huzoor.

Abu Bakar Bin Saeed Sahib, Nazim-e-A'la Midwest Region, was next to report. Speaking with, Huzoor asked, "In the Midwest Region, most of the population of Ansar is of non-Pakistani origin?" Abu Bakar Bin Saeed Sahib replied that it was before; however, now it's around 50/50. Huzoor smiled and asked, "Can you control Pakistanis? It's very much difficult." This was much enjoyed by everyone in the meeting. Abu Bakar Bin Saeed Sahib reported that the next Amila he shall be serving as Qaid Waqf-e-Jadid. "Try to include each and every member, every nasir, in the scheme of waqf-e-jadid," Huzoor said.

Bashir-ud-Din Shams Sahib, currently serving as Nazim-e-A'la Headquaters, reported that this consisted of Maryland, York, Pittsburgh and Baltimore. He added that the tajnid was 525. Shahid Malik Sahib, currently serving as Nazim Virginia, reported that he was given various assignments regarding new immigrants. Huzoor said to implement a special scheme, to "absorb the new immigrants, and to help them, and to settle them."

Nasir Bukhari Sahib, Nazim Great Lakes, reported that the region consisted of Michigan, Ohio, and Kentucky. He added that he would serve as Qaid Talim in the new Amila.

Then, Huzoor said, "Those who are well educated, or can understand, ask them to

read the book: The Philosophy of the Teachings of Islam."

In light of the Ansarullah website, Huzoor said that there should be allocated space "where you give some quotes from the books of the Promised Messiahas, some small excerpts, and quotes of the Khulafa, and quotes on contemporary issues and everything with regards to the teaching of Islam and Ahmadiyyat."

Khuram Shah Sahib, Nazim-e-A'la Central West Region, reported that he will be serving as Qaid Tabligh in the new Amila. Huzoor said, "You should make some ambitious program for tabligh to reach at least 25% of the American population. It is quite ambitious, quite challenging."

Mahmood Butta Sahib, serving as Nazim-e-A'la New York Region, reported they had three Majalis: New York, Long Island, and Brooklyn. Khalid Aziz Ahmad, serving as Nazim-e-A'la Chicago Region, reported that the region consisted of four Majalis.

Atta Karim Chaudhry Sahib reported that he was serving as Nazim-e-A'la Northwest Region. Masood Ashraf Sahib reported that he shall be serving as Nazim-e-A'la Northeast Region. And, Tahir Ahmad Khokhar Sahib

reported he was the Zaeem Rochester, New York.

Following this, Masroor Ahmad Sajid Sahib reported he was the Zaeem Central Jersey. Sheikh Iftikhar Ahmad Sahib reported he was the Nazim-e-A'la of Gulf States. Zafar Abdul Basit Sahid reported he was the Nazim-e-A'la of Southwest Region.

In the end, Huzoor said, "As far as guidance is concerned, I have already given some guidance to some departments and others know already their job – read the constitution."

Then, the Zaeem Sahib of Detroit received the Alm-e-Inami. Following this, members had the opportunity to have group photos.







One of the primary objectives of the Ta'lim department is to promote among Ansar a deeper understanding of the life of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him). The Promised Messiah employed various methods to nurture faith within his community, including elucidating Quranic verses, elaborating on ahadith, and recounting short stories imbued with lessons of

In 2023, with Ansar's emphasis on cultivating stronger family ties and fostering better relationships, our focus turned to recently published books featuring short stories and anecdotes recounted by the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) to his followers. These narratives are drawn from sources such as Malfoozat and various writings of the Promised Messiah.

Syllabus for Ansar 2023: Pleasant Stories and Anecdotes by Promised Messiah (as)

This book predominantly comprises short stories ranging from half a page to a few pages in length. These stories delue into the lives of past prophets, kings/rulers, and saints of the Ummah. Ansar were encouraged to engage in discussions about these stories

with their families at the dining table in their homes. It was hoped that the examples of righteousness depicted in these narratives would inspire Ansar and their households to foster a personal relationship with the Almighty Allah.

In 2023, we conducted only one Ta'lim test, similar to the previous year, with both English and Urdu versions available. The entire test was administered online, allowing Ansar to utilize either a computer or a cell phone. Remarkably, a record-breaking 1,425 Ansar (34%) completed the test this year, marking the highest participation to date.

The Ta'lim department continued its efforts to encourage majalis to organize local book clubs, while the WhatsApp group 'Gems of Knowledge', initiated in 2022, remained active throughout 2023.



2023 Ansar Chanda Status

This year, by the Grace of Allah, we collected a record \$1.424MM in combined Ansar Chanda, Ijtima Chanda and Publication dues. On top of this, we collected over \$250,000 for the Model Village Fund, a new initiative that was inspired by Majlis Ansarullah USA Amila's mulaqat with Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V (aba) during Huzoor's visit to the USA in September 2022.

As usual, we had a challenge again in December 2023, with nearly 30% of Ansar Chanda left to collect at the beginning of the month. Alhamdolillah, Zoama, Muntazimeen Mal and Regional Nazimeen again rose to the occasion, and we surpassed the needed amount with ease. The number of participants increased by 7% to 2,975.




Chanda Participation vs Tajnid

Here we observe the trend over the past 14 years concerning the number of chanda participants and total tajnid. It is noteworthy that our participation as a percentage of tajnid has risen to 70%, up from 65% in the previous year. However, this figure still falls short of the more than 3,000 Ansar who actively participate in Jama'at chanda, leaving over 1,000 members without the spiritual benefits of engaging in Ansar and Jama'at financial contributions.

Inshallah, we are committed to enhancing our participation statistics in 2024. Our goal is to ensure that more members recognize and embrace the spiritual rewards of contributing to Ansar and Jama'at initiatives. By fostering greater awareness and encouraging active involvement, we aim to strengthen our community's commitment to collective financial sacrifices.


Chanda Participation vs Tajnid

Budget vs Collection 2001-2021






2023 % Participation by Majlis

The Isha'at department continues to serve as the communication vehicle for Majlis Ansarullah. Its primary focus is to facilitate communication between the Sadr Majlis, National Amila members, and the broader Majlis membership. Additionally, it helps engage local Ansar in different regions and Majalis by sharing their events, developments, successes, and accomplishments. The department also communicates unfortunate news, such as the demise of our elders and brothers.

In 2023, the Publications Department focused on continuing the bi-weekly Ansar Connection Newsletter, providing an open communication platform for the Majlis. Throughout the year, we released twenty-one issues, covering national and regional events, inspirational stories from members, articles honoring elder members who have passed away, and encouraging events held for Tabligh and Ithar nationwide.

In 2023, Iftikhar Ahmed, Qaid Publications, served as the editor of the Al-Nahl publication, with guidance from Sadr, Mansoor Qureshi Sahib. Naib Qaid Publications, Kamran Mirza Sahib, led the efforts. The team worked diligently and produced excellent issues as planned. Based on feedback from Ansar members, we made some changes, including using professionally taken pictures of Amila, Zoama, and broader events.

The Ansar Connection is emailed to approximately 4,300 Ansar across the US, and a similar number of Al-Nahl magazines are printed and mailed to every household in the US with Ansar members. Feedback from most readers has been positive.

Services to Ansarullah USA:

Grants, scholarships, and loan programs have been initiated to help Ansarullah members as well as youth to address needs and provide encouragement for improving skills and attaining financial independence. In addition to ordinary financial help, assistance in the following categories is available.

Dr. Yusef Lateef Academic Scholarship:

In 2022, Dr. Yusef Lateef Scholarship scheme was launched. Majlis Ansarullah USA has initiated this scheme to motivate Bachelor's or Associate's degree seeking students to excel in their studies and help them complete their education. As such, funds in the amount \$100,000 will be allocated every year. Following scholarships will be available to Ahmadi students:

- 25 merit-based scholarships in the amount \$2.000 each
- 50 need-based scholarships in the amount \$1,000 each

Ansar Tahir Scholarship (Getting a Better Job)

In a struggling economy or a competitive market, many of us must retool ourselves to find and retain jobs which allow us to fulfill our obligations as responsible sons, husbands, and fathers. Ansar Tahir Scholarship is an initiative where deserving members can get up to \$4,000 to improve their job prospects. Funds can be used towards paying for the training and/or tuition of educational and vocational

Majlis Ansarullah Self-Reliance Micro Loan Scheme (SMILE)

Majlis Ansarullah USA has launched Self-Reliance Micro Loan Scheme (SMILE) to help those Ansar who want to start a small business or trade to be able to make a living. This loan scheme is in the spirit of Huzoor's (May Allah ta'ala be his Helper) directions to Majlis Ansarullah USA to help members and emigrants to USA to settle down and make a living by improving skills for a job or starting a small business or trade. This scheme is one of the initiatives of Ithar department. In 2023, a total of 3 loans were given totaling \$30,000.

Free Health Services

Under the leadership of Qaid Dhahanat wa Seḥate Jismani (Intellect and Physical Health), Dr. Tanuir Ahmad, Majlis Ansarullah USA provides medical services to members who call the Ansar services hotline. These included second opinion, prescription as well as medical consultation. Most of the callers are looking for allopathic consultation while a small no. calls for homeopathic cures.




The number of group activities organized around the country were **1014** (892 in 2022). MashaAllah Majalis able to pick this up and organize more activities in 2023.








Are you Safe Awwal or Safe Dom?














Was the "Executing Majlis' Prime Program" session by Rizwan Alladin Sahib, Muawin Sadr useful for you?




How was the transportation experience? (1-5 where 5 is the best) 53 responses




How was your accommodation experience?(1-5 where 5 is the best) 52 responses




What do you feel about the overall duration of this year's ALC program? 53 responses

FROM FEAR TO AMEER-E-KAFILA

This is the story of how fear gave way to triumph

In October 2022, during an audience with Khalifatul Masih (aba) at Baitur Rahman Mosque. the Amila members of Majlis Ansarullah USA were directed to embark on a long-distance cycling journey. Huzoor (aba) specifically mentioned a journey from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, to Silver Spring, Maryland, spanning nearly 350 miles. Inspired by Huzoor's (aba) directive, a group of us decided to take the first step towards this goal by cycling from Austin to Houston to kickoff our upcoming National Ijtima, covering a distance of 140 Despite miles. dealing with colder-than-usual weather completing this journey gave us the confidence to undertake the Pittsburgh ride.

A few months later, I was fortunate to participate in a cycling ride from Aachen, Germany, to Islamabad, England for Jalsa Salana UK. This was a great experience and the international bonds of brotherhood that were formed will always be the highlight of this trip despite the fact that we experienced cold, rainy weather that resulted in some injuries.

Upon my return from England, we began to

focus on the Pittsburgh to Bait-ur-Rahman ride to Majlis Ansarullah Ijtima. Having experienced the ride in Texas and Europe, I was asked to be the Ameer-e-Kafila of this group by then Sadr Majlis Ansarullah USA Imran Hayee. Initially excited, I became increasingly skeptical about its success as the day of the ride came closer. Pittsburgh in October is generally cold, with short days and challenging routes.

Mostly I was concerned about my brothers that such a group of inexperienced cyclists could face a lot of challenges on a week long journey. I thought to myself, statistically, at least one day would be disastrous! I shared all my concerns with Sadr Sahib, suggesting that we either reduce the miles or move the trip to summer to mitigate weather challenges. Sadr Sahib, ever so convinced of the need to follow Huzoor's (aba) instructions, reminded me that Huzoor (aba) himself had recommended this journey, and we must move forward without fear.

Despite numerous challenges, including uncertainty of bike rentals, terrain suitability, support car issues, and accommodation

concerns, we persisted in moving forward. A few days before the journey, the weather forecast predicted light precipitation during the first two days of our trip, confirming the worst of my fears. However, there was no turning back. We offered Sadqa and looked forward to this momentous journey.

On October 2, 2023 we started our journey from the Pittsburgh Mosque. Despite encountering minor problems, such as a broken bicycle at the start of the journey, and facing light precipitation and crashes along the way, we were undeterred. I communicated regularly with Sadr Sahib and shared the details of our trip. His response was always, "Don't worry; we're all praying for you. Huzoor's prayers are with you." This gave us the confidence to persevere.

The ride itself was memorable. Despite never having cycled together, all of us jelled immediately and helped each other whenever any of us needed a boost. One of our brothers even made "dood-pati chai" (Pakistani tea) for us on one of the breaks. We had dinner by the river, and we even shared our food with strangers. We went through a dark and cold tunnel that felt more like a caue. We cycled across the Eastern Continental Divide. We congregational salat. We were wearing our "Muslims for Peace" shirts and several people asked us about our message and wished us well.

There were a few accidents. Almost everyone crashed at least once, but in one case it was quite serious that resulted in visible bruises to the face. Once we arrived at our hotel for the night, I informed Sadr Sahib about the accident. He immediately wrote to Huzoor (aba) for prayers and by the next day a reply was received with prayers for the cyclists. Huzoor (aba) even asked about the









injuries and prayed for the well being of everyone.

After nearly 350 miles, we reached Baitur Rahman in Silver Spring on the morning of October 6. It was an incredible journey, made even more special by the knowledge that we had undertaken it under the guidance of Huzoor (aba). When I saw Sadr Sahib, I thanked him for his persistence, realizing that our fear had indeed given way to triumph. This journey taught me that with the right intentions, fear can be conquered.


