

Message from Sadr Ansarullah, USA

السلام عليكم ورحمة الله وبركاته

Dear Ansar: The Holy Qur'an says: "O mankind, We have created you from a male and a female; And We have made you tribes and sub-tribes that you may know one another. Verily, the most honorable among you, in the sight of Allah, is he who is the most righteous among you. Surely, Allah is All-Knowing, All-Aware." (49:14)

This verse lays down the basis of an all-comprehensive, all-pervading brotherhood of man. The verse, in fact, constitutes the "Magna Carta" of human fraternity and equality. It demolishes false notions of superiority indicating, instead, the need for mutual understanding. All men have been declared equal in the sight of Allah. The worth of a man is not to be judged by the pigment of his skin, nor the wealth he possesses, his rank, social status, descent or pedigree; rather, it is to be accredited to his moral greatness and by the way in which he discharges his duties to Allah and to man. The whole human race is but one family. Division into tribes, nations, and races is meant to give human beings better knowledge of one another, in order that they might benefit from one another's national characteristics and good qualities. On the occasion of the

Last Pilgrimage at Mecca, the Holy Prophet ﷺ said: "O ye men! Your God is one and your ancestor is one. An Arab possesses no superiority over a non-Arab, nor does a non-Arab over an Arab. A white man is in no way superior to a black man nor for that matter a black man is better than a white man, but only to the extent to which he discharges his duty to God and man. The most honored among you in the sight of God is the most righteous among you....." (Note 2797, Short Commentary of the Holy Qur'an, Malik Ghulam Farid).

The Promised Messiah ﷺ and his Khulafa have also consistently negated any and all tendencies of superiority of one race over another among their followers. Hazrat Musleh Mau'ood رضي الله عنه puts it rather forcefully, when he says: "As far as Ahmadiyyat goes, I assure you that we and when I say we—I mean myself and all the Ahmadis who follow me—consider all the people on earth as equals. All of us are equals and have the same powers. I assure you that during my lifetime I am not going to allow any Ahmadi to adopt this mistaken idea. Just as the Holy Prophet ﷺ said that he would crush such ideas under his heels, I also assure you that I will also crush such ideas under my

heels." (Address delivered on January 6, 1951, Rabwah, Pakistan).

I urge all Ansar to become true followers of the Holy Prophet ﷺ and remove even the slightest thought of superiority over any other human being from their hearts. It is equally important to remove any sense of inferiority complex or other feeling of insecurity. Hazrat Khalifatul Masih IV رَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَامٌ has stated: "the narrowness of heart and mind of a person, regardless of his color, always expresses itself in a feeling of inferiority. Many ills of human

society grow out of this complex, but the consequences are extremely devastating if people become its victims in the realm of religion. The Holy Quran tells us that truth and inferiority complex cannot exist together. The two are in direct opposition to each other and cannot flourish together. Truth suffers greatly at the hands of this complex. Like a thing destroyed by termites, one loses faith due to an inferiority complex. It preys upon truthfulness and nobility of character." (Friday Sermon, October 16, 1987). Ansar should not be those who make it a practice to look for reasons to

imagine that seeds of dissension are present in the remarks or actions of others. Keep your minds open and expand your hearts to accommodate everyone sincerely. As elders of the community we must show an extraordinary example of unity and brotherhood since our conduct will be emulated by those who come after us. May Allah enable us all to do our best in this regard, *Ameen*.
