Bikes for Africa

Early this year Majlis Ansārullah USA decided to send a gift of bicycles for 200 Burkina Faso young kids who rode their bikes 1000 KM to attend Jalsa Sālāna and have the opportunity to meet Hadrat Khalīfatul-Masīh V (may Allah be his support) during his visit to Ghana. This scheme was blessed by Hadrat Khalīfatul-Masīh V (may Allah be his support) with his approval. According to initial plan, Ansār were to donate new or used bikes from 3 regions and others were supposed to donate cash to purchase bikes.

Lately, some contacts in Ghana have been discovered who can provide bikes at competitive prices. This should enable us to buy all new bikes while staying within our budget. We are in the process to select a bike suitable for the needs of African terrain. The regions that were assigned to collect bikes are requested to stop collecting bikes at this moment. We may want to resume this after making a separate plan. At this moment our focus is on cash donations. These donations are tax deductible and local Muntazim Finance can collect it and forward it to Qa'id Finance.
