Ta'līmul Qur'ān: Assigned Verses for Memorization

As prescribed in Ta'līmul Qur'ān syllabus of Majlis Ansārullāh, USA, Ruku' 1 and 12 of Sūrah Al-Kahf (Chapter 18) are to be memorized with split meaning during the year 2011. The following verse is assigned to be memorized with split meaning during the month of September.

[18:106] Those are they who disbelieve in the Signs of their Lord and in the meeting with Him. So their works are vain, and on the Day of Resurrection We shall give them no weight.

Ansar National Ijtima' Travel Subsidy Summary

[Complete policy is available from Qa'id Finance and Qa'id Umūmī.]

Members should attend Ijtimā' at their own expense like Jalsa Sālāna. In certain cases, Majlis has and will continue to support where help is needed and requested. Majlis-i-'Āmilah of Majlis Ansārullāh, USA has established the following guidelines for travel subsidy:

- 1. No reimbursement for those who live less than 300 miles from Silver Spring, MD.
- 2. Reimburse 70% of airfare not to exceed \$200, for those who live more than 300 miles away.
- 3. Ansār driving in groups of 4 or more traveling together can request subsidy at \$0.25 per mile (maximum reimbursement \$200). Round-trip mileage between Silver Spring and Majlis can be obtained from mapquest.com.
- 4. Rental of car or van requires prior approval. Za'īm should submit request to Sadr Majlis through Regional Nāzim by September 30. Request should include estimated cost and number of Ansār traveling. Reimbursement will be 70% of expenses.
- 5. Hotel and meal expenses are not reimbursed.
- 6. Special rules and restrictions for Shūrā Delegates have been communicated to Zu'amā.
- 7. For timely reimbursements, please submit completed Ijtimā' Expense Voucher and original receipts to Munawar Saqib, Qā'id Finance, on Friday, October 7 so that checks can be ready on Sunday, October 9.

Journalism Award for a Nāsir
