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السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ وَرَحْمَةُ اللهِ وَبَرَكَاتُهُ: Dear Ansār

One of the objectives of Tehrīk Jadīd is to spread Ahmadiyyat in all parts of the world. In this regard Hadrat Khalīfatul Masih II (may Allāh be pleased with him) said:

"This is the age of publication. And Allāh has ordained to spread Ahmadiyyat all over the world. If Allāh had disclosed to us the most suitable country for the propagation of Ahmadiyyat, we all would have gathered there and become unmindful towards other countries. Therefore, Allah desires us to visit all the countries and look for the one country which would be like Medina for us. With this objective in mind when we visit the whole world we will plant the seed of Ahmadiyyat in each country. Hence, God's objective propagate Ahmadiyyat all over the world would be achieved, and ultimately we would also succeed looking for the country we had in our mind." (Al-Fadl, 29 March, 1935, p. 6)

Hadrat Khalīfatul Masih II (may Allāh be pleased with him) at other occasions said:

"Divine dispensations should always spread their propagation in various countries. So that opposition in one place may be made up for in another. If the members of our Jamā'at spread all over the world they themselves will progress and their progress will affect the Jamā'at as well.

If you fail to spread in the world and went to sleep He (Allāh) would drag you to wake up. And this dragging will be all the harder every time. Thus, spread in the world: spread in the East, spread in the West, spread in the North, spread in the South, spread in Europe, spread in America, spread in Africa. spread in the Islands, spread in China, spread in Japan and spread in every quarter of the world until there be left no corner, no country or no land where you do not reach. So, spread as the companions of the Holy **Prophet** (peace and blessings of Allāh be on him) had spread. Spread as the Muslims of the earlier ages of Islām had spread. Establish dignity of this dispensation through your dignity wherever you may go; cause prosperity to this dispensation through your prosperity wherever you may visit. I wish that centers for the teaching of Ahmadiyyat were established in our lifetime. Thus, the establishment of Ahmadiyya mission houses in far off lands should be the main objective of

Tehrīk Jadīd and this should be done as soon as possible." (Friday sermon of January 16, 1936; Daily Al-Fazl, Vol. 23, No. 21)

"We need manpower to reach the entire world population. We need money to attain this noble goal. We need determination and steadfastness to accomplish this great task. We need desperate prayers to attain this purpose which could attract Allāh's special favors. A composition of all these things is known as Tehrīk Jadīd" (Daily Al-Fadl, Vol. 30, No. 280).

Tehrīk Jadīd fiscal year ends on October 31st. We as Ansār should lead and show by example that each and every Nāsir is contributing towards this scheme. There should be no excuse for not participating in Tehrīk Jadīd scheme. I am sure you can afford to pay one dollar, if not more, even if you are unemployed or retired or have no means of any income. Prayer in Congregation

Abu Hurairah has related that the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allāh be on him) said: "Prayer in congregation is more than twenty-five times greater in merit than Prayer at home or in the shop, etc. Therefore, when a person makes his ablutions carefully and proceeds to the mosque with the sole purpose of joining in the service, his station rises in grade at every step and one of his sins is wiped out. From the moment he enters the mosque he is accounted as a participant in the service while waiting for the service to begin, and, so long as he causes no inconvenience to anyone and his state of purity is maintained, the angels continue to pray for him: Allāh, have mercy upon him; Allāh, forgive him; Allāh, turn to him with compassion." Ansār Tahir Scholarship

Majlis Ansārullāh, USA is offering Ansār Tahir Scholarship to Ansār for up to \$4,000 per year per applicant for a maximum of two year training (maximum amount is \$8,000 per applicant). The scholarship is for vocational training of Ansār to improve their employability and cannot be used as seed money to start a new business. The scholarship will be granted on "first come, first serve" basis. There is no deadline for the application. In most cases payments will be made directly to the training institution. Applications should be submitted through the local Za'īm Ansārullāh. Applicants will be selected based on the following criteria:

- The applicant is a bona fide member of Majlis Ansārullāh, USA in good standing.
- The applicant has exhausted all avenues for employment or wishes to get additional training/education to enhance his employability.
- The applicant has identified a new or alternate career path and is capable and willing to undertake successful completion of the proposed training.
- The applicant has exhausted all available state and federal funding for unemployed and/or displaced workers.
